EMC Associate Teacher Posts

Exciting opportunity for teachers to share their expertise and develop it further

We're looking to recruit a small number of English and/ or Media teachers to the post of 'EMC Associate Teacher' for the 2024/25 academic year to help inform our work. This is a paid position that you will carry out alongside your responsibilities as a classroom teacher.

You will meet regularly with a member or members of the EMC team to provide us with advice and information about key issues in English and Media teaching. In return, we will provide you and your department with access to EMC resources and training.

Payment is £639, the equivalent of a TLR3 point.

We will establish exact expectations of your role after recruitment, depending on your areas of expertise. We welcome applications from teachers specialising in all areas of English and Media Studies from KS3 up to A Level.

We expect all associate teachers as a minimum to:

- Attend two full day meetings / training sessions at EMC outside of term time (travel paid)
- Meet with EMC online once per half-term
- Share student work (with permission)
- Act as ambassadors for EMC's work.

In addition to providing us with advice and information, we would be interested in recruiting teachers who can provide access to their classroom (not more than once per term, with permission; all EMC staff are DBS checked).

We are looking for teachers who share EMC's vision for teaching and are based in a school that is open to dialogic, creative practice.

We welcome applications from teachers from traditionally under-represented groups.

Please send a letter of application no more than 500 words long, outlining your teaching experience and what you would bring to this post to andrew@englishandmedia.co.uk by Monday 3rd June, 9am. You should also provide contact details for two references and attach a signed letter from your Head of Department, confirming that you will be given permission to undertake this work.
